- ★ Special Games involving Tee Ball must be between Regular Season teams only using Regular Season Rules.
- ★ Special Games involving players league age 7 or younger – in coach or player pitch - must use Regular Season Rules.
- ★ Special Games involving players league age 8, 9, and/or 10 may use Regular Season Rules or the 8 to 10 Year Old Tournament Rules, but not the Little League Baseball International Tournament Rules.
- ★ There can be no mixing of Tournament Rules nor mixing of Tournament Rules and Regular Season Rules in Special Games.
- ★ Special Games may only be played during or following the Regular Season.
- ★ Special Games must not be played until written permission is received from Regional Headquarters.
- ★ A copy of this form, with approval or disapproval of Regional Director, will be mailed to the District Administrator.

All requests for Special Games must use this form.

Little League® Baseball does not limit participation in its activities on the basis of disability, race, creed, color, national origin, gender, sexual preference or religious preference.

Insurance Procedures for Special Games w/ Non-Little League

Prior to our consideration of this application, the participating non-Little League® team(s) must provide a copy of their General Liability and Accident Insurance policies that meet or exceed the limits of coverage required for all Little League® programs as provided in Little League® Regulation I(c)(7). For reference, the Accident policy must have a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per person per accident and the General Liability policy must have a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000 single limit bodily injury and property damage as well as include coverage for claims involving 'athletic participants'. The General Liability policy must also list Little League® Baseball, Incorporated as an Additional Insured.
